WHAT TO BRING

- **BRING A FOLDING STAND for All-State rehearsals.**
- Bring your instrument and your music.
- STRINGS Bring mutes and extra strings. LOW STRINGS Bring rockstops and bass stools
- WINDS Bring extra reeds. IF APPLICABLE, bring other instruments (piccolo, English horn, etc)
- BRASS bring MUTES needed for your parts.
- PERCUSSION Bring MALLETS needed for your parts.
- You are responsible for all valuables (cell phone, tablet, wallet, purse).

BRING A FOLDING MUSIC STAND

- **10:00AM -12:30 Register in Exhibit Hall A** (Lower Level, down two floors from main floor, Convention Center) We encourage you to take time to explore the colleges, universities, retailers and organizations in the exhibit hall!
- 11:45 AM **Optional** All-State Jazz Band Concert (Ballroom, Convention Center).
- **1:00 PM Report to Symphony Ballroom, [Hilton Hotel](#), 1001 Marquette Ave S, 2nd floor.**
- 1:15–4:20PM All-State Orchestra rehearses in Symphony Ballroom.
- 4:30-4:40PM Walk to Orchestra Hall, mezzanine lobby
- 4:40-5:00PM Box sandwiches at Orchestra Hall (vegetarian, gluten free, dairy free, vegan options. All are nut and shellfish free.)
- 5:00-5:15PM Walk back to Hilton Hotel
- 5:25-7:15PM Rehearsal continues at Hilton Symphony Ballroom.
- 7:30-8:45PM **Optional** Concert from The Concordia Band and the Medalist Concert Band, Ballroom, Convention Center: Parents can pick you up at 7:15 at the Hilton Hotel or you may attend the optional concert at the Convention Center. If you attend the concert, parents can pick you up at the 2nd Avenue entrance to the Convention Center.

SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 16

BRING A FOLDING MUSIC STAND.

- **8:30-11:00AM Rehearsal at Hilton, Symphony Ballroom.** (Breakfast on your own prior to rehearsal.)

- 11:30AM Check out of hotel by 12:00 noon. Lunch with your parents or dine on your own. Make sure you allow enough time to dress for the concert.
- **1:30PM Meet backstage at [Orchestra Hall](#)** (1111 Nicollet Mall). Enter Orchestra Hall through the Stage Door entrance located on Marquette Ave between 11th and 12th Streets. Family members, friends, or other audience members must enter Orchestra Hall through the lobby.
- **2:00-4:30PM MMEA All-State Bands and Orchestra Concert.** The **Orchestra performs first**, the Concert Band is second, the Symphonic Band is third. After you pack belongings, an usher can lead you to a seating area. You can also leave Orchestra Hall via the stage doors.

CONCERT DRESS

- Top: Black button-up shirt or blouse. Tie optional
- Bottom: Dress pants or skirt (knee length or longer).
- Black dress allowed (knee length or longer).
- Black shoes.

CONCERT SAT 2:00PM ORCHESTRA HALL

- Students report to stage door on Marquette Ave between 11th and 12th St at 1:30PM.
- No food or drinks on stage.
- No luggage backstage please.
