FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 15

- **10:00AM-12:30 Register in Exhibit Hall A** (Lower Level, down two floors from main floor, Convention Center) We encourage you to take time to explore the colleges, universities, retailers and organizations in the exhibit hall!
- 11:45 AM **Optional** All-State Jazz Band Concert (Ballroom, Convention Center).
- **1:00 PM Report to Room 200A** in the [Minneapolis Convention Center](#).
- 1:15–4:10PM All-State Tenor Bass Choir rehearses in Room 200A.
- 4:10 – 4:20PM Walk to Westminster Presbyterian Church (about 1 ½ blocks)

- 4:20-4:40PM Box sandwiches at Westminster (vegetarian, gluten free, dairy free, vegan options. All are nut and shellfish free.)
- 4:40–4:50PM Walk back to Minneapolis Convention Center, Return to Room 200A
- 5:00-7:15PM Rehearsal continues in Room 200A
- 7:30-8:45PM **Optional Concert: The Concordia Band and the Medalist Concert Band - Ballroom, Convention Center:** Parents can pick you up at the 2nd Avenue entrance to the Convention Center at 7:15 or after the concert concludes.

SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 16

- **8:45AM Report to Orchestra Hall** via Stage Door entrance off of Marquette Ave. Report to assigned room to drop belongings and wait to be escorted to Rehearsal Room
- 9:00AM Vocal warm-ups in Rehearsal Room
- 9:30AM Rehearsal begins on-stage
- 10:00AM Rehearsal ends. Pick up belongings.
- 10:00AM Exit Orchestra Hall to complete hotel checkout and change to concert dress
- **10:45AM Return to OH** assigned room and remain until escorted to Rehearsal Room

- 11:00AM Pre-Concert warm-ups in Rehearsal Room
- **10:30AM Concert begins.** Concert order: Mixed Choir, Soprano Alto Choir, **Tenor Bass Choir.** After performance pick up belongings from assigned room and follow ushers to auditorium. Be seated for the concert. You may depart Orchestra Hall via the stage door.

CONCERT DRESS

- Concert dress is what you wear for your school concerts - for example robe, tuxedo, dress

CONCERT SAT 10:30AM ORCHESTRA HALL:

- Students report to stage door according to schedule.
- No food or drinks on stage.
- No luggage backstage please.
